1. HMS 121 and 250 will be substituted for HMSV 343; HMS 141 and 258 will be substituted for HMSV 447 or 448 (with the exception of those wishing to take a substance abuse track, in which all courses for the track are required).
2. Choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> in the following categories: 3 credits in Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, or Literature. Also ensuring these courses fulfill the electives required for the AAS.
3. Student may receive hours that could be applied to the final internship at ODU.
4. These courses can be taken at ODU or VCCS. If taken at VCCS, student must choose courses from ODU's VCCS Transfer Guide <http://www.odu.edu/transfer/vccs-transfer-guide.html> 6 credits in any of the following categories: Philosophy and Ethics, Human Creativity, Literature, Interpreting the Past, or Foreign Language; and 8 credits in the category of Nature of Science.
5. For students pursuing credentialing as a CSAC or CADC following graduation, HMSV 447 must be taken as the HMSV elective. Additionally, HMSV 452 must be selected as part of the required curriculum instead of HMSV 494. Please see the section in the catalog entitled Substance Abuse Course Sequence for additional information.

- *Lower-Division General Education waiver and course substitutions are not automatic upon enrollment to ODU, students must notify academic advisor for these to be processed upon verification.*
